

## Warranty

The goods sold by NUFFIELD EXPORTS LIMITED are supplied with the following express Warranty of the Manufacturer

1. **WARRANTY.** The Manufacturer warrants that, subject as mentioned below, during the period of TWELVE MONTHS or 12,000 MILES (or 20,000 km.), whichever first occurs, from the date on which Goods (as defined below) are delivered to the first owner thereof, it will exchange or repair any part which needs replacement or repair by reason of defective material or workmanship in manufacture. Parts repaired or replaced free of charge under the Warranty will be subject to the Warranty during the balance of the Warranty period applicable to the Goods. A second or subsequent owner of the Goods will be entitled to claim under the terms of this Warranty during the balance of the Warranty period.

2. **LIMITATIONS.** No claim will be met under this Warranty if the Goods have been :

- (a) Used for competitions, racing, or record attempts, or otherwise than for the private or commercial use of the owner or any previous owner;
- (b) Abused in any way or damaged by wear and tear, neglect, improper use, or failure to maintain in accordance with the Manufacturer's or Distributor/Dealer's recommendations;
- (c) Altered in a manner not approved by the Manufacturer, or fitted with any part not approved by the Manufacturer for fitting to the Goods ;
- (d) Altered by the removal or change of the Manufacturer's identification numbers or marks; or
- (e) As respects a chassis, fitted with a body which in the opinion of the Manufacturer is unsuitable.

3. **EXCLUSIONS.** This Warranty is given in place of all warranties, conditions, and liabilities whatsoever given by the Manufacturer or the Manufacturer's associated export company or their servants or agents or implied by common law, statute, or otherwise, all of which shall accordingly be excluded. Furthermore, the Manufacturer and the Manufacturer's associated export company and their servants and agents shall not be liable for any claim for personal injuries or consequential liability, damage, or loss whatsoever, howsoever caused.

4. **PROCEDURE FOR CLAIMS.**

- (a) The owner will not be charged for the repair, or removal and replacement, of any part found to be defective within the terms of this Warranty, provided that, immediately upon discovery of the alleged defect, the owner takes the Goods to a Distributor/Dealer for the repair or removal thereof.
- (b) If, in case of emergency, the owner is unable to take the Goods to a Distributor/Dealer, the Manufacturer will consider a Warranty claim and make such allowance in

respect of material and labour as it shall, in its absolute discretion, think fit, provided that the owner :—

- (i) Immediately upon the discovery of the alleged defect, makes a direct claim upon and returns the part or parts complained of, to a Distributor/Dealer;
- (ii) Furnishes to the Distributor/Dealer particulars of the Goods and the chassis and engine number of the Goods as shown on the identification plate attached to the goods.
- (c) The owner must give to the Distributor/Dealer full particulars of the claim and the reasons therefor, the date of purchase, the total operating mileage of the Goods up to the discovery of the alleged defect, and the name and address of the Distributor/Dealer from whom the Goods were purchased when new.
- (d) Unless otherwise requested, the alleged defective part may be scrapped fourteen days after the notification of the Manufacturer's decision, or, in the case of a reference under Clause 6, fourteen days after the decision by the referee.

5. **SPECIAL BODYWORK.** Where special bodywork has been fitted after approval by the Manufacturer as being suitable for fitting to the chassis concerned, this Warranty shall continue to apply to the chassis. Approval by the Manufacturer of the bodywork for this purpose shall not, however, imply that the bodywork is included in the terms of this Warranty.

6. **DISAGREEMENT.** Any disagreement between the Manufacturer and the owner claiming under this Warranty as to its interpretation shall be referred for determination to a single referee to be appointed in the absence of agreement by such motoring organisation or other body as shall be agreed. All matters affecting this Warranty shall be determined in accordance with English law.

7. **DEFINITIONS.**

- (a) "Goods" means new vehicles or parts thereof, including replacement parts manufactured or supplied by the Manufacturer as part of the standard equipment of such vehicles as well as non-standard accessories approved by the Manufacturer, but excluding tyres.
- (b) "Owner" means the owner or user of any Goods.
- (c) "Distributor/Dealer" means a person, firm or company under contract with a subsidiary company of The British Motor Corporation Limited or with a concessionaire or distributor of any such subsidiary company to supply or service Goods.

8. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Warranty is effective for Goods sold retail from the 1st August, 1963, until further notice.

# CONDITIONS OF SALE

In all contracts for the sale of Vehicles and Parts (hereinafter referred to as "goods") the Distributor and his dealers shall incorporate the following conditions :

1. All goods are sold subject to and with the benefit of the manufacturer's Warranty, a copy of which is available at the office of the Seller.
2. The specification of the goods may be altered at any time by the manufacturer without notice and the Seller reserves the right to deliver the goods in fulfilment of this order conforming to the manufacturer's prevailing specification at the time of delivery.

## AFTER-SALES SERVICE

Morris Distributors and Dealers are under agreement to give 'Inspection and Adjustment Service' after a running period of 500 miles and before completion of 1,000 miles to Morris vehicles purchased from them and they will effect the service attention listed below without charge except for materials.

1. Drain oil from engine, gearbox, and rear axle and refill.
2. Oil and/or grease all points of the car as called for on lubrication chart.
- \*3. Examine, and adjust if necessary, sparking plug and distributor points.
4. Tighten cylinder head, rocker shaft bracket, and manifold nuts to specified torque.
5. Adjust tappet clearances.
- †6. Check venturi/fuel pump linkage for free action and full butterfly opening. Check that governor and venturi seals are intact. Check vacuum pipe unions (venturi to governor), or
- \* Examine and clean carburetter; check slow-running and choke adjustments. Check fuel pipe connections.
7. Check fan belt tension.
- ~~8. Top up battery; clean and tighten terminals.~~
9. Check all electrical connections and functioning of complete electrical system.
10. Check clutch pedal for prescribed free movement.
11. Check fluid levels in brake, clutch, and power steering reservoirs.
12. Check operation of braking system; bleed if necessary.
13. Check front wheel alignment and all steering connections.
14. Check tightness (to recommended torque where specified) of universal joint nuts, wheel nuts, and road spring 'U' bolts and leaf clips.
15. Inspect shock absorbers for leaks. Examine fluid levels, and top up if necessary (piston type only).
- ‡16. Check doors for ease of opening and closing. If necessary, lightly smear with a suitable lubricant all dovetails and striking plates.
17. Road-test vehicle.
